


PT. JERSEY HAMMERS NEWARK IN RIVALRY SHOWDOWN


BATTLE OF NEW JERSEY NEWCOMERS TO APBL ENDS IN LAUGHTER IN JERSEY CITY

JERSEY CITY, N.J. (July 18, 1878) – New Jersey rivals and A.P.B.L. newcomers Newark & Port Jersey met for the final time this season on Thursday, and the result was a spectacular Pt. Jersey home win at Hoboken & Oakland Park:

After five innings Port Jersey was ahead 5-0, a healthy lead but certainly nothing that was insurmountable. However, after Newark again went scoreless in T6 the hosts came to bat and did the following:

And with that, Port Jersey was ahead by the score of 19-0 and the win over their long-time Jersey rivals was firmly in hand. Two more runs in the next inning on a Double by Dixon gave the game its 21-0 final score.

The man responsible for the Shutout was Port Jersey #1 Charles King:

- PtJ P Charles King: CG SHO (19-11, 2.76), 5 HA, 0 BB, 1 K

The crushing victory improved the record of Pt. Jersey, easily the league's biggest surprise this season, to 34-29, good for a tie for fourth place in the Colonial Conference at four games behind leaders Shamrock through 63 games of their maiden A.P.B.L. campaign. Newark has been nowhere near as fortunate, going 16-47 so far in their first A.P.B.L. season.
