

NEWARK CLOBBERS ORANGE TO GIVE HOSTS 1ST LOSS

VISITORS SCORE EARLY & OFTEN TO WIN BY 22; FETTERMAN BATS 5/7; ORANGE WERE 4-0

MANHATTAN, N.Y. (May 6, 1882) – Orange went into Saturday's game vs Newark looking to extend their perfect start to 1882. Instead, they were on the receiving of a beating at the hands of their visitors from New Jersey.

Newark started the game brilliantly with a five-run opening inning, the Runs coming via Base on Balls, Single by RF Clarence Pearson, Single by 1B William Trowbridge, run-scoring Double Play, and Error. From there the visitors had the rule of the roost, taking an 8-1 lead by the end of the third inning, then increasing it to 10-1 with a pair of Runs in T5, and then ending the contest with a nine-run rally in T6 that put them ahead by the score of 19-1.

Orange scored three times in B6 but that mattered little to Newark, who scored seven more times over the late innings to leave the Upper Manhattan Grounds with a massive 22-run victory that gave reigning Pitcher of the Year Andrew Miller his first Win with his new team, as well as his first against his former team.

Seven Newark batsmen had multiple Hits, two of those had three, and CF Thomas Fetterman led everyone with five:

- T1: Leadoff Single to LF off W. Bertelli (R)
- T2: Leadoff Double to RCF off W. Bertelli (R)
- T3: 1-run Single past 2B off W. Bertelli

- T5: Fly Out to RF (2 out)
- T6: 2-run Triple to RCF off L. Busker (R)
- T7: Reached via Error by SS (R)
- T8: 1-run Single past 2B off L. Busker (R)
- TOTAL: 5/7 (2B, 3B), 5 R, 4 RBI, 8 TB – 95 GmSC

The loss was Orange's first during the opening week of the season (4-1), while the emphatic victory left Newark with a 2-3 record. The series concludes tomorrow afternoon.
