

NIAGARA HAS FIVE THREE-HIT MEN IN SUNDAY W

COBB, NORMAN, MYERS, BARROW, & LEMMON ALL POUND THE BALL AT QUAKER ST.

PHILADELPHIA, PENN. (May 7, 1882) – Niagara entered the finale of the first week of play in 1882 looking to win at Quaker State and finish it with a 3-3 record. The visitors from Buffalo did just that thanks to excellent batsmanship.

At the Philadelphia Cricket Grounds, the result was never in doubt. Niagara started the affair with seven Runs over the first two innings, the big moment a three-run Inside the Park Home Run by 1879 B.o.t.Y. William Norman with one out in the top of the opening stanza.

After that, the visitors were never in much danger. Quaker St. was able to reduce their deficit to three when they scored via Passed Ball & Error in B7 to make it a 10-7 game, but Niagara sealed the win with a four-run rally in T9 capped by a run-scoring Single from C John Bachant.

The key to Niagara's seven-run win was found in the middle of their lineup, as batsmen #3-7 all had at least three Hits.

The result gave both teams a 3-3 record to end Week One of the 1882 A.P.B.L. season. Niagara opens Week Two with a series vs American, while Quaker St. will travel to Pittsburgh to play three games at Alleghany.
