Johnson stepped into the Batter's Box seven times and cracked hits in six of them:

- TOP 1ST: Leadoff Single
- TOP 3RD: Infield Single
- TOP 5TH: Bunt Single
- TOP 6TH: Infield Single
- TOP 7TH: Single
- TOP 9TH: Single
- TOTAL: 6/6, 3 R, SB

Thanks to Johnson's efforts, Bedford won the contest at Empire B.B.C. by the score of 13-8 in front of a little over 1,300 spectators. The two teams combined for 32 hits.
